

## Shared Living for Young Men with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASDs)

### **Lurie House — Brighton, MA**

Lurie House offers 4 private rooms, ample shared living space, and support services for young men in their 20's and 30's. This home is in a safe beautiful Brighton neighborhood.

Amenities include:

- Easy access to the Green Line and six bus routes
- Shared kitchens and on-site laundry facilities
- Wireless Internet service
- Cable television in common living rooms

#### Service Plans: Supported Independence

Residents receive three hours of individual service per week to help them build the skills for independent living. Also included are two hours for weekly group activities within the program focused on building social skills.

Staff members help residents manage paperwork and finances, keep medical appointments, set up social and recreational activities, find volunteer opportunities, and stay organized.

Residents also have access to staff as-needed during normal working hours. Families and Residents are able to purchase additional staffing hours through JF&CS.

### **Requirements**

All Lurie House residents are expected to:

- Have scheduled activities (school, job, volunteer work, etc.) four days a week
- Keep appointments with staff members and work with them to meet personal goals
- Keep room reasonably clean, remove food-related trash on a daily basis, and complete assigned household chores
- Participate in weekly group meetings

Fees:

\$2,100/month. Monthly fees cover rent, support services, utilities, and Internet service.

Families and Residents are able to purchase additional staffing hours through JF&CS.

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
